

CLASS ACTION LAWSUIT PROCESS

A GUIDE FOR RV OWNERS

WHAT IS A CLASS ACTION LAWSUIT?

A **class action lawsuit** allows a group of individuals with similar claims to come together and file a lawsuit against a company. In this case, the lawsuit seeks to hold RV manufacturers, like Jayco, Keystone, and Heartland, accountable for defective RVs that have led to structural issues and safety concerns. By joining the class action, RV owners can collectively pursue compensation for the harm caused by these defects.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO JOIN THE CLASS ACTION?

You may be eligible to join the class action lawsuit if:

- You own a **Jayco, Keystone, Heartland**, or other affected RV model with structural defects, such as **cracks near the slide-out**, frame instability, or other safety-related issues.
- You have experienced **recurring problems** that the manufacturer has failed to adequately repair.
- Your RV has **lost value** or required significant repairs due to these defects.
- You have incurred **financial losses** related to repairs, replacements, or loss of use.

WHAT ARE MY LEGAL RIGHTS IN A CLASS ACTION?
